## Emergency Pedagogy – More than Methods

Wars, violence, and natural disasters threaten many—but especially children are affected by the feeling of nowhere being safe. They find it especially difficult to understand and process man-made disasters.

Pedagogical and therapeutical offerings can help to lessen their traumata and prevent trauma related disorders. We invite all persons interested in this topic to the sixth emergency pedagogy annual conference in Karlsruhe.

### Goal of the Conference:

How are the development and lives of children affected by man-made disasters? How can we prevent these hardships from becoming stress factors, which lead to traumata? And how can emergency and trauma pedagogy help to integrate experiences into one's biography? We want to explore these questions together.

### Programme

This year's speakers are **Andreas Müller-Cyran** (leader of the crisis intervention team (KIT) and emergency pastoral care in the archdiocese of Munich), **Dr. med. Christian Schopper** (head doctor of the psychosomatic specialist clinic Sonneneck, Badenweiler), **Dr. phil. Dima Zito** (trauma therapist, Psychosocial Centre for Refugees Düsseldorf, doctoral thesis about child soldiers), **Bernd Ruf** (special education and Waldorf pedagogue, school director of the Parzival Centre), and **Ralf Willinger** (advisor for children's rights at terre des homes).

Also at this year's conference a diverse programme made up of exciting lectures and educational workshops is waiting for you!

### Event organizer

The Friends of Waldorf Education developed a comprehensive concept for emergency pedagogy in 2016, a first pilot project followed. Since then many crisis missions in war and catastrophe regions have been carried out. The work is now supported by various other NGOs and governmental organisations.

In addition to emergency pedagogy, the organization has been supporting and advising Waldorf-pedagogy initiatives since 1971 and coordinates educational sponsorships for children from low-income families. The Friends have been active in the area of voluntary services since 1993 and organise services for more than 7,000 volunteers in more than 54 countries worldwide.
